- 1. Urgent application is allowed.
- 2. Applicant/accused is present alongwith his Advocate who has been heard for grant of protective bail in his favour in Crime No.123 of 2012 registered under Section 324, 337-H(ii), 337-A(ii), 403, 147, 148, 504, 114 PPC at P.S Kazi Ahmed.

It is stated by the learned counsel for the applicant/accused that the case against applicant is false and has been registered due to enmity. He further submitted that after registration of the case the applicant/accused appeared before the Trial Court from where he succeeded in obtaining bail and this fact is evident from the order dated 31.07.2012, but subsequently applicant shifted to Karachi and he was not aware about the dates of hearing of the case, however, he was declared proclaimed offender. Learned Counsel further submitted that in fact applicant intends to appear/surrender before the concerned Court to face the trial but apprehends his arrest at the hands of police. Serious allegations of malafide have been alleged against police.

Without touching the merits and de-merits of the case and in order to enable the applicant/accused to appear before the concerned court for pre-arrest bail, he is granted protective bail for a period of 07 days commencing from today, subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and P.R Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. In case the applicant/accused fails to appear before the concerned court within the stipulated period the surety amount shall be forfeited.

This order shall cease to have effect after expiry of 07 days or when the applicant surrenders before the concerned court, whichever is earlier.

In view of the above, this bail application stands disposed of.
