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Mr. Aijaz Bhutto, Advocate files vakalatnama on behalf of petitioner,
whereas, Mr. Imam Bux Solangi, Advocate files vakalatnama on behalf of
private respondents No.6 and 8. Both vakalatnamas are taken on record.

Today, detailed written statements have been filed on behalf of private
respondents as well as official respondents. According to the learned A.A.G,
earlier the brother of petitioner has issued two cheques in connection with a
business transaction which cheques were dishonored and culminated into
criminal proceeding, which was subsequently compromised. The latest factual
development in the case has been narrated by the Counsel for private
respondents, who has submitted that above criminal case in respect of FIR No.
215/2016 was compromised in consideration of a cheque of Rs.15,50,000/-
issued by present petitioner to the private respondents, which subsequently also
on presentment in the Bank has been dishonored and as an evidence of which,
the Counsel has placed on record it as annexure E/1. The subject cheque of
Rs.15,50,000/- and the Bank Slip are reflecting that the same was bounced on
account of insufficient funds in the account of petitioner.

The petitioner seeks time to file a detailed rejoinder so that the background facts can be highlighted before the Court, which request is declined on account of admitted position in the matter.

Basic legal maxim is that the person who seeks equity should come with equity and also come in Court with clean hands. This ingredient is absent from present petition and therefore, the same being de void of merits is dismissed alongwith listed application.
