## ORDER.

Applicant is alleged to have committed robbery of Motorcycles, Mobile phone Samsung J-5, and Rs.1000/- from complainant, a Mobile phone and cash of Rs.5000/- from his brother Gada Hussain and One Mobile phone and cash Rs.1000/- from PW Bashir Ahmed alongwith co-accused on 25.01.2016 while the complainant party was going on the link road from Masudero to Mirpur Bhutto at about 8:30 PM. Subsequently, the Motorcycles were shown recovered in F.I.R bearing Crime No.16 of 2016 registered at Police Station Ratodero under section 324,353,148 PPC wherein allegedly the applicant by leaving the said Motorcycles escaped away.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity; that there is delay of one day in registration of F.I.R which has not been explained; that the story is improbable as the applicant is co-villager of the complainant therefore, his false implication cannot be ruled out.

On the other hand learned APG opposed grant of bail to the applicant.

Complainant was served with notice for today but he has chosen to remain absent.

I have considered the submissions of the parties and perused the material available on record. Applicant is admittedly co-villager of the complainant and in the circumstance the delay in registration of the F.I.R does not appear to be explicable. More so the recovery of robbed motorcycle is surrounded in mystery as the same were allegedly left by the applicant in an encounter with the Police in which admittedly no one was injured. In the facts and circumstances the case of applicant requires further inquiry. Accordingly he is admitted to bail subject to furnishing a solvent surety in the

sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand) and PR bond in the same amount to be executed before the trial court to its satisfaction.
