- **1.** Urgency is granted.
- **2.** Deferred.
- 3. Through this bail application, applicant/accused Qaim-uddin, son of Eidan, by caste Mahar, seeks protective bail in Crime No.26 of 2023 under Sections 382, 506-II PPC, registered at Police Station Adilpur, District Ghotki.

Learned Counsel for applicant/accused contends that applicant is innocent, has been falsely implicated in this case. He further contends that applicant/accused is ready to appear before the Court concerned along with an application under Section 498 CrPC to prove his innocence, however, he apprehends his immediate arrest as non-bailable warrants has been issued against him; hence, he seeks protective bail.

Without touching merits and de-merits of the case, protective bail for a period of **seven (07) days** w.e.f. 13.09.2023 to 19.09.2023 (*both days inclusive*) is granted to applicant/accused subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.20,000/-(*Rupees twenty thousand*) and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Operation of non-

bailable warrants in this case shall remain suspended during aforesaid period of seven (07) days. Applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the Court concerned in the aforementioned period. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of above seven (07) days period or whenever applicant/accused surrenders before the Court concerned, which one occurs earlier. It is, however, made clear that in case applicant/accused fails to surrender before the Court concerned within stipulated period, his bail bond shall stand automatically forfeited.

Criminal Bail Application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
