It is the case of the petitioner that he was offered a post of Sub-Inspector (BPS-9) in Cooperative Societies Sindh Department vide letter dated 16.11.2009 and through a letter dated 19.11.2009, he communicated his acceptance of the said post to Respondent No.1 / the Registrar, Cooperative Societies Sindh, Hyderabad but subsequently he was not appointed. We have seen the comments of respondent No.1 which show that the petitioner was matriculate in D grade, whereas, the educational qualification for the said post was matriculation in 2nd division, therefore, he was not appointed being unqualified. However, we have noted that although the petitioner is matriculate in D grade but his marks were not counted to confirm whether his was 2nd division or 3rd division, because if his marks are 45% or above, he would be placed in 2nd division despite his D grade in matric. When confronted with this fact, the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Tando Muhammad Khan has submitted that if the petitioner provides his marks sheet certificate of matriculation, they would seek its verification from the Board and count his marks, and if he is found to have obtained 45% marks and is in 2nd division, then his case would be considered in accordance with law. This statement has satisfied the learned counsel for the petitioner who seeks disposal of the petition in the said terms and at the same time undertakes that marks sheet certificate of matriculation of the petitioner would be provided to the respondents within 10 days hereof.

The petition is disposed of in above terms.
