# ORDER

**MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J:-** Through captioned bail application, applicants seek post arrest bail in case Crime No.373/2024, u/s 302 read with Section 201, 34 PPC at Police Station Clifton, Karachi.

- 2. As per brief facts, from a flat in Tauheed Commercial Area, Plot No.C-1, 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Phase-V, DHA Karachi, dead body of father of complainant was found on 29.10.2024 along with a pistol, an empty, and a knife. As per statement of learned DPG in the post-mortem, the deceased was found to have died out of firearm injuries
- 3. Applicant Suret Rehman was arraigned in the case on basis of the fact that he was tenant of the said flat, which he had sublet to the deceased. Whereas, applicant Nawab @ Gulpana was made accused in the case on the basis of the fact that he used to visit deceased in the same flat. However, the main allegations are leveled against Muhammad Raza, whose location through phone was traced at the place of incident at the relevant time.
- 4. Learned defence counsel has reiterated the above facts and grounds for bail, which has been half-heartedly opposed by learned DPG.
- 5. Prima facie, there is no direct evidence against the applicants except that one was tenant of the flat and the other used to visit deceased in the said flat. In the circumstances, a case of further enquiry is made out and the applicants are granted post-arrest bail subject to their furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/ (Rupees one lac) each with P.R. bond in the like amount to be executed to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
- 6. Needless to mention that the observations made herein above are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial. The bail application is disposed of in the above terms.
