Applicant Muhammad Mushtaq has been booked in crime No.878/2024 under Section 324/34 PPC registered at P.S Surjani Town, Karachi and applied for post arrest bail which was declined by the Court of VIIth Additional District and Sessions Judge (West) Karachi vide order dated 16.08.2024. Hence he has approached this Court for post arrest bail.

2. The brief facts of the case are that the complainant Muhammad Hamza is a mechanic and on 18.7.2024 he had a dispute with his cousin Abdul Salam and his sons at about 2030 hours. The elder brother of the complainant Muhammad Noman went to Mushtaq, Raza, Shahzad and Hassan and others in order to resolve the dispute. However, Mushtaq, Raza and Shahzad became aggressive and started to beat up Noman with lathi and dandas. In the meantime Mushtaq assaulted and also stabbed Noman who sustained injuries and was taken to hospital. Hence the aforesaid FIR was lodged against the applicant.

3. Today complainant Muhammad Hamza and injured Noman are present and state that they have compromised the matter with the applicant in Court and have forgiven him in the name of

Almighty Allah and under these circumstances they have no objection to the grant of the post arrest bail to the applicant. Under these circumstances learned APG has no objection to the grant of post arrest bail. Accordingly post arrest bail is granted to the applicant namely Muhammad Mushtaq subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac Only) and P.R Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Nazir of this Court.

4. The instant criminal bail application is disposed of in the above terms.
