Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied if he may be granted a similar order dated 05.06.2025 passed by this Court in C.P No.D-2362/2025. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has no objection to such proposition. For the sack of convenience, the material part of order dated 05.06.2025 is reproduced as under:-

“We find that Customs Appellate Tribunal is clogged up with heavy backlog of cases. Under these circumstances, it would not be fair to the Petitioner, if we would not allow release of the goods, especially, when the petitioner is prepared and ready to pay the differential amount keeping in view of no objection given by the learned counsel for the Respondent No.2.

Accordingly, we disposed of this petition and order that the Petitioner may deposit the disputed amount of duties and taxes as mentioned in the Order-in-Original directly with the concerned Collectorate, whereas in respect of the fine and penalty as adjudicated in the Order-in-Original, the Petitioner shall furnish Pay Order or Bank Guarantee to the satisfaction of the Nazir of this Court and once the Bank Guarantee or Pay Order is furnished, Nazir issue appropriate certificate for such consignment separately. Nazir’s fee is fixed at Rs. 10,000/- for each certificate to be issued by his office.”

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of in terms of order dated 05.06.2025 passed by this Court in C.P No.D-2362/2025.
