“It is respectfully submitted by and on behalf of the Respondents that in compliance of order dated 12-02-2020 (Stay Order) the Office Order bearing No. SZIC/Esst/N.T/Dir/2019 dated 21-10-2019 (Compulsory Retirement Order) has not been acted upon.

In the meanwhile the Petitioner has retired on account of superannuation on 01-12-2024 vide Offer Order bearing No. SZIC/Estt.Pen.N.T/2025-02 dated 03-02-2025.

The Office order dated 21-10-2019 (Compulsory Retirement Order) shall not be acted upon and shall be deemed as withdrawn by the Office Order dated 03-02-2025 as the pensionary benefits have been released by the Respondents and received by the Petitioner.”

Since the purpose of filing of the instant Petition is served out, therefore, the Petition is disposed of by directing the Respondents to pay the entire benefits, gratuity, commutation etc. within thirty (30) days in accordance with law, if outstanding.

The Petition stands disposed of along with pending applications.
