- 1. Urgency is granted.
- 2-3. Applicant seeks return of surety on the ground that he stood as surety for both accused-applicants in this case who were granted interim pre-arrest bail by this Court vide order dated 12.10.2020, which was later on confirmed vide order dated 07.12.2020. Counsel contends that after grant of interim pre-arrest bail, the applicants/accused surrendered before the Court of III-Additional Sessions Judge, Karachi (South) ("trial Court") and faced the trial in S.C.No.555/2021. He further contends that vide order dated 24.08.2024, learned trial Court has kept the said Sessions Case in abeyance against applicants-accused till production/appearance of complainant/victim and cancelled the PR bonds and discharged the sureties after six months of said order subject to execution of Bond in the sum of Rs.100,000/- each for their appearance before the trial Court as and when required.

In the circumstances and principles discussed in the judgments of the High Court of Sindh,¹ the surety documents are released/returned to the applicant-Surety <u>SUBJECT</u> to the applicant-Surety submitting to the <u>Nazir</u> Statement of the applicant-Surety attaching the certified copy of the P.R. bonds in the sum of Rs.100,000 each, filed afresh with the trial Court as per the above-mentioned Orders of the trial Court.

Accordingly, the application for the return of surety is allowed in the above terms subject to the above condition. The Office is directed to ensure compliance and release surety and P.R. bonds in terms of this Order and after proper verification and identification, and as per the rules.
