therefore, the Secretary, Local Government Department is directed to
decide the representations made by the Additional Director, Local
Government Department within one month's time and relocate the
petitioners to any other suitable place. The petitioners are warned that if
they remained absent from their duties, they shall not be entitled for their
salaries.

Learned counsel, being satisfied, seeks disposal of instant petition, which is not opposed by the learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh. Order accordingly.
