ORDER

Muhammad Jaffer Raza, J. Through the instant petition, the Petitioner seeks a writ against the elections of the Pakistan Blind Association ("**Association**"). It has been contended by the learned counsel that the elections are to be held on 25.10.2025 and he apprehends that the process will be contrary to the by-laws of the Association. Through the instant petition a thorough inquiry and independent audit of all financial accounts of the Association is also sought.

We have specifically confronted the learned counsel as to how the instant petition is maintainable against the Association¹ and the private Respondents, under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973. The learned counsel in this regard was unable to render any assistance or identify any provision of law which would warrant invoking the writ jurisdiction of this court.

In the light of the same, it is held that the instant petition is devoid of merit and the same is dismissed *in limine*.
