Through this Criminal Misc. Application, the applicant has impugned the order dated 09.09.2025 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Jacobabad, whereby the learned Ex-Officio Justice of Peace has directed the SHO, P.S concerned to record statement of the respondent/complainant, if a cognizable offence is made out and then incorporate the same in FIR.

Per learned counsel, the applicant has paid the entire amount and no such offence has been committed by the accused.

On the other hand, Mr. Nadeem Ahmed Khoso, Advocate files Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.3, which is taken on record. He as well as learned Deputy P.G, Sindh support the impugned order.

From the face of record, it appears that proposed accused issued a cheque bearing No.1969570625 dated 01.08.2025 amounting to Rs.25,00,000/- and when it was presented before the Bank, same was dishonoured due to insufficient funds. Since the applicant/complainant has disclosed a cognizable offence and it is settled principle of law that falsity or truthfulness of allegation can be ascertained through the process of investigation which is yet to be done by the police.

Accordingly, instant Criminal Misc. Application is **dismissed**. However, the SHO, P.S concerned is directed to comply with the order passed by the learned trial Court.
