The Petitioner seeks direction for registration of FIR against Respondent No.5, alleging that he, in collusion with bank officials, fraudulently withdrew Rs.3,200,000 and Rs.182,000 from her bank account, which amount she claims was received as pensionary benefit of her husband. It is further stated that the matter was reported to the FIA, which initiated an inquiry, but no final report has yet been furnished. The Petitioner also sought direction for production of the said inquiry report. However, during the proceedings, the Petitioner withdrew the prayer seeking registration of FIR, expressing intention to approach the competent authority for appropriate relief.

- 2. We have heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Assistant Attorney General as also examined the material available on record. Since the matter is already under inquiry by the FIA, and the Petitioner has not shown that any representation has been made to the Deputy Director FIA or any other competent authority for expediting the inquiry or providing a copy of the report, the instant petition is premature. Accordingly, the petitioner may approach the concerned FIA authorities, including the Deputy Director, for redressal of her grievance. If a representation is made, the concerned authority shall decide the same within a reasonable time in accordance with law. Needless to say, no cause arises at present for any direction to be issued by us under the prevailing circumstances for the name of the private Respondents to be placed on the ECL.
- 3. With these observations, the petition stands disposed of along with pending applications.
