The official respondents present today have filed their statements, which are hereby taken on record. At this stage, Mr. Mumtaz Ali Jessar, Advocate, undertakes to file Vakalatnama on behalf of private respondents No.8 to 10 and submits that due to the death of their cousin, they could not appear today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1, being sui-juris, has contracted marriage with petitioner No.2 of her own freewill, and respondents No.8 to 10 are allegedly causing harassment to them. It is further submitted that, at the behest of said private respondents, officials of various police stations are also extending harassment; hence, the present petition has been filed seeking protection.

Conversely, learned Assistant Advocate General Sindh submits that the official respondents have categorically denied the allegations of harassment and are fully committed to act strictly in accordance with law and extend due protection to the petitioners. Mr. Mumtaz Ali Jessar, learned counsel also submits that respondents No.8 to 10 neither caused any harassment to the petitioners nor do they intend to harass them in future.

In view of the above statements, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks disposal of the petition with directions that the petitioners be provided legal protection.

Accordingly, the present constitutional petition stands disposed of, with directions to the official respondents to ensure that no harassment is caused to the petitioners and that they shall act strictly in accordance with law while providing legal protection to the petitioners. The private respondents No.8 to 11 are also restrained from causing any harassment to the petitioners.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to the official respondents as well as learned A.A.G. for information and compliance.
