ORDER

Omar Sial, J.- Muhammad Muslim Bambal has sought post-arrest bail in Crime No. 01/2024, registered under sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 477-A, 34 P.P.C read with section 5(2) Act-II, 1947 at the ACE police station, Jacobabad.

2. The F.I.R. was lodged by Safdar Ali Junejo, Inspector/Circle Officer, ACE Jacobabad on behalf of the State on 26.02.2024 on the pretext of withdrawing the pension amount.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for the accused and the learned D.P.G.. My comments and observations are as follows.

4. Reason No.1. The applicant is accused of withdrawing the pension due to a lady named Zamiran Khatoon. Learned counsel for the applicant has put on record evidence, which upon a tentative assessment shows that Zamiran Khatoon has herself been withdrawing the pension.

Reason No.2: Learned counsel has argued that the malafide of the police is evident from the fact that Zamiran Khatoon's section 161 Cr.P.C statement has not been recorded to date.

5. The above two points were raised by the learned counsel for the applicant on previous hearing and sufficient opportunity was given to the Anti-

Corruption Establishment to come and to show whether what he says is incorrect. The Anti-Corruption Establishment has failed to do so. Seeing the conduct of the Anti-Corruption Establishment, I cannot exclude malafide at this preliminary stage.

6. Given the above, the case against the applicant is one of the further inquiry. He is, therefore, admitted to post arrest bail against a surety of Rs. 200,000 and a PR Bond for the same amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.
