ORDER

OMAR SIAL, J:- Manzoor Hussain has sought pre-arrest bail in Crime No.307/2024, registered under sections 337-Fvi, Fi, Ai, 506/2, 147,148, PPC registered at PP Sadar Police Station Sadar City. His bail application, which was filed before learned Sessions Judge, Kamber-Shahdadt, was dismissed by II- Additional Sessions Judge, Kamber, on 11.10.2024.

2. Crux of the case are that on 06.09.2024 at about 1300 hours complainant Mst. Waziran lodged F.I.R that she is married to one Bashir Ahmed Buledi and from that wedlock she has one son and three daughters, few days ago, her husband exchanged harsh words with her over domestic matter. On 31.08.2024 at about 04:00 pm, her brother and her mother came at house of her husband Bashir and she was sitting with them, saw Basheer son of Faiz Muhammad and sons of Brother-in-law Babar, Manzoor both sons of Shahban, Siraj son of Muhammad Buledi, Amanullah son of Nadir Hussain Buledi, asked her husband for permission to go with her in laws, on which her husband went annoyed and instigated accused, on his instigation, accused Amanullah caused danda blow which hit her on her left arm, she fell down, accused Manzoor, Babar, Siraj caused kicks and fists blows to her, then her brother and mother pledged of Holy Quran to accused, accused Amanullah, Manzoor took out pistols from their folds and pointed at them issued threats of murder and then went away. Thereafter they brought the injured at P.S and after getting letter took treatment and she lodged this F.I.R.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned Deputy Prosecutor General. The complainant did not affect his

attendance. I have listened to the counsel and gone through the available records.

3. Learned Counsel submits that co-accused Babar and Amanullah have been granted bail even though it was Amanullah who is accused of causing fracture to the injured. I am quite surprised that the learned trial Judge while granting bail to two co-accused for reasons best known to it has declined to give same concession to the present applicant. The impugned order does not give any reason as to why the learned trial court drifted away from the ground of consistency.

4. Given the above, the interim pare arrest bail already granted to the applicant is confirmed on same terms and conditions.
