Learned Counsel for the applicant submits statement along with the order dated 01.07.2024 as referred in the earlier order of this Court. In the said order, the preliminary enquiry was concluded by the concerned Magistrate, as according to the said report, material inter alia being the torn clothes was not produced. Learned Counsel for the applicant contended that the torn clothes were secured by the concerned official when the FIR proceeding took place earlier, which was later disposed of under 'C' class. In this regard, he has referred to the memo. Apparently, failure was present on part of the applicant to get the statement of official recorded who had procured torn clothes.

Irrespective to the same that the material was not produced by the applicant before the concerned Magistrate, learned Counsel for the applicant required the matter to be disposed of as not pressed contending that the finding in the matter may not adversely affect any complaint of the applicant made subsequently, as according to him, continuation of wrong and harassment is being made on part of the private respondents.

Respondent No.4, present, files statement of his advocate along with photocopies of the documents, and denies that any harassment is being caused on his part.

Matter stands **disposed of as not pressed**, wherein the findings made on account of failure of the applicant, no adverse inference is found liable to be made against the applicant and in favour of the respondents for any further proceedings available in accordance with law.
