The offences with which the applicant(s) are charged are either bailable or fall within the non-prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.P.C. Keeping in mind the principles enunciated in the case of Tariq Bashir & 5 others v. The State (PLD 1995 S.C. 34), I do not see any exceptional or extra-ordinary reason to deny bail to the applicant; secondly there is an inordinate delay of two months in registration of this FIR for which no explanation is on record; mala fide can therefore not be conclusively ruled out at this preliminary stage. Given the above, the applicant(s) are admitted to post-arrest bail against a surety of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lac) each and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial court..
