**Muhammad Saleem Jessar, J.:-** At the very outset, learned advocate for the applicant states that the differential amount involving in the case against applicant Ali Murtaza Abro is Rs.17,58,200/- out of which Rs.10,00,000/- have been deposited by the applicant in favour of the SSGC. As far as the remaining amount is concerned, it is to be paid / deposited by co-accused Shahid Abro, who is absconding. He, therefore, submits that the case against the applicant/accused requires further enquiry.

The arguments advanced by the learned advocate for the applicant have not been opposed by the learned Law Officer / D.M. SSGC and the learned Assistant Attorney General as well as the complainant, present in Court, and they have also extended their no objection to the confirmation of bail earlier granted to the applicant.

Heard arguments of the learned advocate for the applicant, learned Law Officer/D.M of the SSGC and the learned Assistant Attorney General and have perused the material available on record. Since the differential amount against the applicant has been deposited by him in

favour of the S.S.G.C and such assertion is affirmed by the learned counsel for the department. In the circumstances and in view of no objection extended by other side, the case against applicant requires further enquiry within the meaning of sub-section (2) of Section 497 Cr.P.C. Accordingly, instant bail application is allowed and the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the applicant vide order dated 18.07.2019 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and condition. As far as the trial is concerned, the applicant shall continue his presence before the learned Trial Court without fail.
