2. Granted.
3. The applicant Mst. Shamshad Khatoon has been booked in Crime No.5/2015 registered with Police Station ACE, Kandhkot for offences punishable under Sections 409, 467, 468, 470, 471, 34, PPC read with Section 5(2) Act-II of 1947.

Learned Counsel submits that after submission of challan the trial Court viz. Court of Special Court, Anticorruption (Provincial), Larkana while taking cognizance has issued NBWs against the applicant in Criminal Case No.43/2015 re State v. Abdul Nabi Kalwar and others. Counsel submits that the applicant being retired government officer is also semi-paralyzed and has been produced in Court on wheel-chair but she apprehends her arrest because of the NBWs issued by the trial Court in terms of his order dated 24.2.2017. In support of his contentions, he has placed on record certified true copy of case diary dated 24.2.2017 of the trial Court showing issuance of NBWs against the applicant.

Mr. Sardar Ali Shah, learned Assistant Prosecutor General, present in Court in other matters, waives the notice and raises no objection to grant of protective bail to the applicant.

Be that as it may, without touching merits of the case, the applicant is admitted to protective bail for a period of seven days from today in order to enable her to surrender before the learned trial Court for seeking appropriate relief subject, however, to her furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court.

Needless to mention that this protective bail granting order shall cease to operate on expiry of seven (7) days from today or when the applicant shall surrender before the learned trial Court, whichever occurs earlier.

Bail application stands disposed of in above terms.
