**ORDER**

**MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J.** Applicant Yousuf Khan S/o Shams-ur-Rehman is seeking post arrest bail in Crime No.470/2026 U/s 9(i) 6 (a), 9 (2) 2 CNS Act, 2024 registered at P.S. Darakhshan, Karachi.

2. Applicant was arrested from Khiyaban-e-Mujahid, Street No.11 DHA Karachi by a Police team of P.S. Darakhshan headed by ASI Ali Hassan along with co-accused Abdul Raheem Yousuf on 08-07-2026. From both of the accused separate narcotics were recovered. From applicant allegedly 12 grams of heroin was recovered, hence they both were booked in the present case.

3. Applicant’s counsel has pleaded for bail on the ground that he is first offender; the offence does not fall within the prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr. P.C; that co-accused Abdul Raheem has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 04.08.2026 passed in Criminal Bail Application No.2257 of 2026; investigation is over and applicant is entitled to bail. On the other hand learned Addl.P.G. has opposed for bail.

4. However, we are of the view that since the applicant is the first offender, the offence does not fall within the prohibitory clause of

Section 497 Cr. P.C. and applicant is no more required for further investigation as the investigation is over. The co-accused Abdul Raheem has been granted bail. This application is allowed and the applicant is granted bail subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

5. The observations made herein above are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.

6. This Cr. Bail Application is disposed of alongwith listed application.
