ORDER

Muhammad Iqbal Kalhoro, J:- Applicant is seeking post arrest bail in a case bearing Crime No.80/2026, u/s 9(1)(6)(c) of Sindh CNS Act, 2024 of Police Station Risala, Karachi by means of this application.

2. Applicant was arrested by a police team headed by SIP Gul Akhtar of Police Station Risala from the Meat Market near Moin Steel Market, Karachi on 18.04.2026, and allegedly from him 515 grams of heroin was recovered, hence, he was booked in the present case.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has pleaded for bail on the ground that applicant was picked up from his house prior to the registration of FIR, against which his uncle had filed an application u/s 491-A CrPC before the District & Sessions Judge South, Karachi, on 17.04.2026. In response to which a raid was conducted at Police Station but before that applicant was removed therefrom, and on the next date, he was shown to have been arrested in the present case.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl: PG Sindh has opposed bail.

5. We have asked the Investigating Officer (IO) about the investigation, if any done by him over filing of application prior to registration of FIR against illegal detention of the applicant by uncle. But he seems oblivious to such application or its outcome, which shows that he has not conducted a proper investigation in the matter and just has followed blindly what was already written in the FIR. Hence, we find the case against the applicant to be one of further inquiry, and cannot rule out his false implication. Accordingly, this application is allowed and applicant is granted bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/ (Rupees one hundred thousand only)

with P.R. bond in the like amount to be executed to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

6. Bail application stands disposed of in the above terms. The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.
