While numerous questions proposed for determination, learned counsel demonstrates from the record that goods adjudged to be smuggled in nature has been directed to be released on payment of redemption fine etc. Learned counsel states that same is *prima facie* contrary to the law. Learned counsel states that notwithstanding foregoing, the impugned judgment comprises of four paragraphs of reproduction leading to a single dissonant conclusive paragraph. In such regard, learned counsel states the impugned judgment is not a speaking and has been rendered in a perfunctory manner without independent deliberation of facts and circumstances.

Under such circumstances, learned counsel seeks that the impugned judgment to be set aside and the matter remanded back to the learned Tribunal for adjudication afresh in accordance with law. Order accordingly.
