It is not disputed by respondent No.1 that the petitioner was appointed on  
'disabled quota' as he is a disabled person. Besides, he is discharging his duties  
without any complaint and his performance is upto the mark.

Learned State Counsel has no objection if the service of the petitioner is  
regularized.

Professor Dr. Abdul Hameed Channar, Regional Director (Colleges),  
Sukkur present in court also affirms that the petitioner is discharging his duties  
honestly and diligently to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.

Since the petitioner being disabled person was appointed on 'disabled  
quota' and his superiors are satisfied with his performance and have extended no  
objection for the regularization of his service; in view of above, this petition is  
allowed. Consequently, respondents are directed to regularize the service of the  
petitioner within a period of 15 days and ensure that his salaries from January,  
2013 and onward are released without any hindrance. Non-compliance of this  
order may expose the respondents for contempt of court proceedings.
