Imran son of Yaseen Siyal has sought post arrest bail in crime number 776 of 2025 registered under section 380/34 P.P.C. at Sukhan police station. Earlier, his application seeking bail was dismissed on 12.01.2026 by the learned IVth Additional Sessions Judge, Malir Karachi.

A back ground to the case is that the aforementioned F.I.R. was registered by Complainant on 18.12.2025 with regard to the theft of his three buffaloes on 12.12.2025. He made search at his own and came to know that accused Imran, Abdul Hafeez and Jahanzaib have committed the theft.

I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant, Complainant in person and learned D.P.G. Sindh.

The only evidence against the applicant/accused is that one of the buffaloes was tied with a rope and the rope was held by Imran. There is no other evidence against him. There is a seven days delay in lodging the FIR. The delay is unexplained at the moment. The offence with which the applicant/accused is charged falls within the non-prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Keeping the principle enunciated in the **Tariq Bashir and 5 others vs The State (PLD 1995 SC 34)**, I do not find any exceptional or extraordinary circumstances to deny the applicant bail.

In view of the above, the applicant is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the amount of Rs.100,000 and a P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
