ORDER

Adnan Iqbal Chaudhry J. – 1] Urgency granted. 3] Exemption granted subject to all just exceptions. 2&5] Petitioner has challenged a notice dated 09-07-2026 issued by the Official Assignee Karachi, calling upon the Petitioner to vacate subject premises for auction in compliance of order dated 07-07-2026 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court on an Execution Application to enforce a decree passed by this Court in the Banking jurisdiction. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that said order was passed without hearing him. M/s. Arbaz Yar Khan and Ahmed Ali Hussain Advocates enter appearance for Respondent No.1 and auction purchaser. They waive notice and oppose the petition.

Apparently, the impugned letter by the Official Assignee Karachi is issued on orders passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court. Thus, the Petitioner essentially seeks a *writ* against a Judge of the High Court, which *writ* is prohibited by sub-Article (5) of Article 199 of the Constitution of Pakistan. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further acknowledges that against the order dated 07-07-2026 passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court, the Petitioner has already filed a High Court Appeal which is pending before another Division Bench of this Court. That becomes an additional reason for the non-maintainability of this petition. Therefore, for said reasons, the petition is dismissed in *limine*.
