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Office has listed this matter for order as to non-prosecution as learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to provide requisite sets as well as cost for issuing notices. Today learned counsel for the petitioner appeared and requests for ten days’ time for making compliance. Time is allowed. Adjourned to a date to be fixed by the office.

It may not be out of place to mention here that it has been observed on repeated occasions that despite orders having been passed for issuance of notice, the petitioner and/or learned counsel fails to deposit the requisite process fee, costs and sufficient sets of copies necessary for issuance and service of notices. Consequently, office is constrained to place such matters before the Court for appropriate orders regarding non-prosecution, thereby consuming the valuable time of the Court. In view of above recurring situation, it is hereby directed that, where an order has been passed for issuance of notice, the petitioner shall ensure deposit of the requisite process fee, costs and sufficient sets of copies, as required for issuance and service of notice, before next date of hearing. In case the petitioner fails to comply with aforesaid requirement within the stipulated period, the office shall not be required to place the matter before the Court for orders on account of such non-compliance. Instead, the matter shall be deemed to have been dismissed for default/non-prosecution, subject to any order to the contrary passed by the Court.
