Through this petition, Petitioner Owais Ilyas son of Muhammad Ilyas, who is stated to be in UAE, through his attorney Umais Javed seeks protective/transitory bail in FIR No. P-984/2019-JIAP (Arrivals) under sections 2(s), 16 & 139 of the Customs Act, 1969 punishable under section (8)m (89) & (70) of Section 156(1) Ibid, Read with Baggage Rules notified vide SRO-666(1)/2006 dated 28.06.2006 & Section 3(iii) of Import & Export (Control) Act, 1950 pending before Spl. Judge (Customs Taxation & Anti-Smuggling) Karachi. It is contended that contended that Petitioner is prepared to surrender before the trial Court in the aforesaid FIR and arriving Pakistan on 13.08.2026 but apprehends his arrest at the hands of respondent/complainant on his arrival at Jinnah International Airport, Karachi, hence this petition. Learned counsel files copy of air ticket under cover of his statement dated 12.08.2026, which is taken on the record.

Since petitioner is prepared to surrender before the trial Court, without touching the merits of the case, protective/transitory bail is granted to him for a period of eight (08) days from today, subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Thousand) and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Nazir of this Court. Ministry of Interior Government of Pakistan is directed to lift the name of petitioner from block list for eight days (08) days from today, if appearing in the block list.

This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of eight (08) days from today i.e. 19.08.2026 or when the petitioner surrenders before the concerned trial court, whichever is earlier. The instant petition alongwith office objection stands disposed of.
