Pursuant to order dated 24.08.2026, official respondents submitted their reports/replies to the petition, which are taken on record.

2. This petition has been instituted for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus. Mr. Aamir Mansoob Qureshi, learned Advocate, files Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No. 5, which is taken on record. He submits that, due to a mental disorder disease, the alleged detainee has been admitted to Willing Ways Pakistan, North Nazimabad, Karachi, where he is undergoing treatment.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has also placed on record a certificate dated 15.08.2026, issued by Willing Ways Pakistan, confirming that the alleged detainee, Muhammad Nadeem, aged 57 years, has been admitted to the said facility. Since the instant petition has been instituted for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus, it appears that the alleged detainee is not under confinement, but has been admitted to a psychiatric facility for treatment. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, being the sisters of the alleged detainee, have been denied the right to meet him. He, therefore, requests that the Director/Consultant Psychiatrist of Willing Ways Pakistan may be directed to arrange a meeting of the petitioners with the alleged detainee, Muhammad Nadeem.
4. The said request has not been opposed by Mr. Aamir Mansoob Qureshi, learned counsel for respondent No. 5; however, he submits that such meeting may be permitted in the presence of the alleged detainee’s wife, children, and other immediate family members.
5. Since the alleged detainee is admitted to Willing Ways Pakistan, Nazimabad, Karachi, the Director/Consultant Psychiatrist of Willing Ways Pakistan is directed to arrange a meeting of the petitioners with the alleged detainee, Muhammad Nadeem, in the presence of his wife, children, and immediate family members on **02.09.2026** at a

time convenient to the Hospital/Institution. The parties shall be given prior notice of time of such meeting.

6. Petition stands disposed of. Petitioners shall be at liberty to approach the Court of Protection established under the provisions of Mental Health Law, if so advised.
