- 2 to 5. Through these proceedings petitioners seek for the following relief:-
- (a) To direct the respondents Nos.1 and 2 to cancel the registration of illegally registered cooperative maintenance society of respondent No.3 with registration No.K-2586/2026;
- (b) To grant permanent injunction against the respondent No.3 by directing/restraining that respondent No.3 is not entitled to demand control of accounts of maintenance from the petitioner nor entitled/authorized to collect or demand maintenance from residents of Gulshan-e-Maymar;
- (c) To restrain the respondent No.3 from demanding or control of accounts of maintenance of petitioner, billing, collecting or recovering any maintenance charges from the residents and allottees of Gulshan-e-Maymar and from issuing any demand notice, billing or taking coercive action against any resident/allottee in respect thereof during the pendency of the instant constitutional petition and may further be pleased to suspend or keep in abeyance the operation and effect of the respondent No.3;
- (d) Any other relief which this Hon’ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances.

After arguing the matter to some extent, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has now been instructed by the petitioner not to press the instant petition provided direction is issued to respondent No.1 namely The Secretary Sindh Cooperative Societies, having office at Barrack No.19, Sindh Secretariat, Karachi, to decide their Appeal pending adjudication before him within a period of two (2) months after providing ample opportunity of hearing to all the parties mentioned therein, copy of the Appeal is attached with the memo of Petition as Annexure P/14 (page 83).

In the given circumstances, Const. Petition No.D-5560/2026 is disposed of alongwith all pending applications with direction to respondent No.1 to decide the aforementioned Appeal positively within a period of two (2) months from the date of receipt of this order and make compliance report to this Court through MIT-II of this Court.
