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Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing the matter at some length, was confronted with regard to the maintainability of the instant constitutional petition in view of sub-rule (2) of Rule 53 of the Sindh Cooperative Societies Rules, 2020, as well as the unreported judgment passed by the Hon’ble Federal Constitutional Court in F.C.P.L.A. No.73-K of 2026 (*Sindh Secretariat Cooperative Housing Society Ltd. & others v. Province of Sindh & others*). Upon such confrontation, learned counsel submits that instead of pressing the instant petition as a constitutional petition, the same may be treated and converted into an appeal and placed before the appropriate Regular Bench.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel, the instant constitutional petition is permitted to be converted into an appeal, subject to all just legal exceptions, including those relating to its maintainability, limitation and competence. Learned counsel for the petitioner shall file an amended title page and make good any other office requirements within seven (07) days. Upon compliance, the office shall assign the appropriate appeal number in accordance with the applicable rules and practice and place the matter before the Regular Bench, as per roster.

Till the appearance of the respective parties before the Regular Bench, the interim order already operating in the matter shall remain in force.
