Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Admittedly, the petitioner was employed by PIAC. He has approached this Court for setting aside his premature compulsory retirement and also prayed for the reinstatement in the service w.e.f. 01.09.2014 with all back benefits. Time and again the hon'ble Supreme Court has held that PIAC has no Statutory Rules of Service, therefore, no relief can be granted in writ jurisdiction. The relationship of the employer and employee of the PIAC is of master and servant and appropriate remedy is to invoke the jurisdiction of Civil Court for redress of the grievance. The learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to file a suit for the relief claimed in this petition. In view of the above, the petition is dismissed with the pending applications. However, the petitioner is at liberty to seek appropriate relief in accordance with the law.
