MUHAMMAD ALI MAZHAR J. The case of the petitioner is that his father was serving as DSP in Sindh Police, who retired from his service in the year 1975, however, he expired in the year 1985. It is further stated that the deceased left behind the widow and the petitioner as his legal heirs. Initially the petitioner applied for the post of Constable in the employees quota. In the application it is further stated that his father had expired on 21.06.1985. The Senior Superintendent of Police AEC/CID Counter Terrorism Unit, Sindh Karachi forwarded his application on 26.11.2012 to the DIG Police, CID, CTU Sindh, Karachi for his appointment as Constable on son quota. Similar recommendations were also made on 14.04.2013 to the Additional Inspector General of Police Karachi Range. One more Letter dated 15.04.2013 is available on record, which was sent on behalf of Additional Inspector General of Police Karachi Range to the Senior Superintendent of Police, CID, Karachi Range. The last letter

was written on 19.06.2013 by the SSP, AEC/CID, Sindh Karachi to DIG Police, CIA, Sindh, Karachi in which it is stated that all requirements have been fulfilled and requisite documents are attached and further request has been made that the case of the petitioner may be forwarded to the competent authority. The record shows that some efforts have been made in the case of the petitioner, which has been recommended and forwarded to the competent authority but no final order has been passed so far on the application. The comments of the AIGP (Legal) are available, in which only a plea has been taken that under the purview of Standing Order No.260/2011, the retired Police officers/personnel can claim job not later than five years of reaching the age of superannuation. It is further admitted in the comments that at present the father of the petitioner has expired after retirement.

Mr. Ayaz Ali Kakepoto, DSP Legal is present with learned A.A.G. They have confirmed that the application of the petitioner is pending, which will be decided in accordance with law within two months. Petitioner's counsel is satisfied. Petition is disposed of in the above terms.
