Muhammad Ali Mazhar J On last date we called the respondent No.4. Today he is present. The petitioner has challenged his transfer order on the premise that due to illness of his father it is very difficult for him to perform his duty at Kotri, as he is the only person to look after his father, who is suffering from paralysis. Learned counsel for the SITE submits that the SITE has no statutory rules of service, therefore, this petition is not maintainable. His contention seems to be correct, however, at the same time he argued that application of the petitioner will be considered sympathetically by the department on humanitarian grounds if he has some genuine reasons against his transfer order.

2. Since the SITE has no statutory rules of service, therefore, this petition is dismissed along with listed applications. However, as argued by the learned counsel for SITE, we expect that the petitioner's application for recalling his transfer order shall be considered by the Department sympathetically on humanitarian grounds.
