Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Petitioner has approached this court for the directions that the management of Civil Aviation Authority be directed to promote the petitioner in terms of applicable Rules.

- 2. Learned counsel argued that petitioner's batch mates have been promoted but this treatment was not given to the petitioner and he has become the victim of discrimination.
- 3. The comments are available on record. Counsel for the Civil Aviation Authority referred to para-7 of the counter affidavit in which it is stated that ten persons have been promoted to PG-5 as per Rules. So far as petitioner is

concerned, his performance was not up to the mark and standard. It is further stated that petitioner was considered in D.P.C convened in the year 1993 and 1995 but he was not recommended for promotion due to his adverse A.C.Rs for the years 1991 and 1994.

- 4. It is quite strange that on the basis of adverse A.C.Rs for the years 1991 and 1994, the petitioner's case still hanging and even in the year 2016 the department is referring to adverse A.C.Rs of 1991 and 1994. Nothing has been placed before us to show that the case of the petitioner was sent for consideration in the current D.P.C except the reference of D.P.C held in the year 1993 and 1995.
- 5. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the C.A.A. (Respondent No.2) submits that the case of the petitioner will be considered in the next D.P.C and if he is found eligible on the basis of his A.C.Rs he will be promoted in accordance with the Rules/Policy. Petition is disposed of accordingly along with pending applications.
