ORDER

MOHAMMAD ALI MAZHAR---J.,The learned counsel for the Petitioners argued that all the petitioners are performing their duties on daily wages basis. The contractual obligation was being extended by the respondents after completing eighty nine (89) days from time to time. Learned counsel for the petitioners refer to Page 139 Annexure-C/2 which is a letter dated 02.05.2013 issued by the Deputy Director Establishment Prime Minister's Secretariat, Pakistan Bait-ul-Mal Government of Pakistan. This letter was addressed to all the Directors Pakistan Bait-ul-Mal Provincial / Regional Offices whereby the decision taken in the meeting of Cabinet sub-committee held on 13-03-2013 regarding regularization of Contract / Adhoc / Fixed pay and Daily Wages Employees was intimated. The learned counsel for the petitioners argued that despite clear directions, no effort has been made for regularization of the Petitioners services. The learned counsel further pointed out that similarly placed employees filed Petition No. 7674 of 2015 in the Lahore High Court which was disposed of

and in compliance the Respondents issued Regularization of Services of the petitioners who filed Petition in the Lahore High Court.

2. The Learned Standing Counsel filed the comments of respondent Nos. 2 & 3 along with his statement in which Syed Mansoor H Gerdezi, Law Officer, Pakistan Bait-ul-Mal Cabinet Division Islamabad refer to the order passed by the Islamabad High Court; and it is further stated that the cases of the petitioners along with other employees are under process and the decision of the committee constituted by Cabinet Division for regularization of contract and daily wages employees shall be implemented in letter and spirit.

3. In view of the comments, this petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondents to consider the cases of petitioners for regularization within two months in terms of letter dated 02.05.2013 available at page 139 of this Constitution Petition which was sent by the Deputy Director Establishment to the all Directors Pakistan Bait-ul-Mal Provincial / Regional Offices for regularization of contract and daily wages employees.
