None present for applicant. It appears from the record that accused Shahzado and Muhammad Hassan were granted interim pre-arrest bail by this Court on 26.09.2016 subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- each and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. It also appears from the record that after passing the said order the accused are not appearing before this Court without any reason or intimation.

I have gone through the order dated 26.12.2016. For the sake of convenience it would be proper to reproduce the said order which reads as under:-

*“Applicants are called absent. Call report from trial Court, whether applicants are appearing before trial Court. Office shall also send surety papers to the trial Court. In case of non-appearance, trial court would be competent to issue proceedings against applicants.  
As an indulgence with last chance, adjourned to 23.01.2017.”*

It appears from the record that in compliance of the said order the accountant of this Court has sent the surety papers submitted in this case by surety to the Trial Court. Learned Counsel for complainant present in Court has submitted the copy of order dated 24.02.2017 showing that the Trial Court after completion of the legal and codal formalities and after declaring the accused proclaimed offender has kept the case on dormant file till arrest of the accused.

As observed above, none is present on behalf of applicants/accused, therefore, this bail application is dismissed in non-prosecution. Office is directed to facsimile the order of this Court to the Trial Court as well as Police Station Sakrand for information and compliance.
