Through the instant Constitution Petition petitioner Allah Warayo has prayed for the following reliefs:-

- a). That this Honourable Court may be pleased to issue directions to the respondents No.1 to 5 to provide the protection and safety to the petitioner and his family from the clutches of respondents No.5 to 11 and treat them like respectable citizens as guaranteed in the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- b). Direct the respondents No.3 and 4 not harass the petitioner and his family members at the instance of respondents No.5 to 11.
- c). Direct the respondents No.2 to 4 not register any FIR against the petitioner and his family till prior permission of t his Honourable Court.

At the time of hearing of the petition learned counsel for petitioner did not press prayer clause No.(d). The same was deleted. Comments are filed on behalf of respondents No.2,3 and 4. S.H.O. Police Station Mithi, in his comments mentioned that there is a dispute between the parties over the plot. All the respondents have denied of causing harassment to the petitioner.

Learned Advocate for petitioner submits that private Respondents are causing harassment to the petitioner by using the influence of police officials. Learned A.A.G. submits that no harassment whatsoever has been caused to the petitioner and they are bound to provide protection to the petitioner as provided in the law.

As regards the dispute over plot is concerned the same shall be decided by the competent court of law whenever the parties approached.

In the view of above, counsel for petitioner express his satisfaction and doesn't press the instant Constitution Petition more and it is accordingly 'disposed of'.
