1. Granted.

2. Exemption allowed subject to all just exceptions.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in Crime No.05 of 2007, registered at Police Station Bathoo Forest District Matiari, whereas according to learned counsel the co-accused persons have been duly acquitted by the Judge Anti-Terrorism Court Hyderabad Division Hyderabad in A.T.C. case No.13 of 2007 vide Judgment dated 3.11.2011. Per learned counsel the applicant did not know about registration of aforesaid F.I.R. or pendency of the case before Anti Terrorism Court who has recently come to know about such F.I.R. as the police has raided his house, whereas it has been learnt that N.B.Ws have been issued by the Anti-Terrorism Court in which the applicant has been declared as absconder. Per learned counsel the applicant is willing to surrender before the trial court provided protective bail is granted to the applicant.

Without touching merits of the case, in order to enable the Applicant to appear and surrender before the trial Court, the Applicant is admitted to protective bail for ten (10) days from today subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/-(Fifty thousand) and P.R. bond in the like sum to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court.

In case the Applicant fails to surrender before the trial Court within the time specified, surety furnished before this Court shall stand forfeited.

This bail shall remain effective up to 22.06.2017 or when the applicant surrender before the trial Court whichever is the earlier.

This criminal bail application stands disposed of.
