It is the case of the petitioner that she was married to respondent No.4 Mureed Khan, but after marriage it transpired that he was already married, he was involved in bad habits like drinking and he also had relations with criminals. In this background, the petitioner returned to her parents and filed F.C. Suit No. 1376 of 2016 for dissolution of her marriage which was decreed vide judgment dated 30.03.2017. She has alleged that respondent No.4 is constantly threatening and harassing her even after dissolution of their marriage. Respondent No.4 Mureed Khan is present in person. He concedes that petitioner is not his wife any more. Without admitting the allegations levelled by her against him, he undertakes not to harass or intimidate the petitioner or any of her family members in any manner whatsoever. It has been made clear to him that if any complaint is received in this behalf against him, stern action shall be taken against him in accordance with law. Respondent No.2 SSP Hyderabad and respondent No.3 SHO PS A-Section, Latifabad, Hyderabad, are directed to keep close watch on respondent No.4 Mureed Khan and to provide full and proper protection to the petitioner in case of any harassment or threat to her by him.

By consent, the petition stands disposed of in terms of the above undertaking and direction.
