Mr. Samad Ali Advocate holding brief for M/s Sarfaraz Ali Metlo and Amir Bux Metlo Advocates, who are appearing in Suit No. 1790 and 1791 of 2017. Same learned counsel also undertakes to file Vakalatnama of Mr. Amir Bux Metlo Advocate for defendant No. 4 in Suits No. 1792 of 2017 and for defendants No. 4 & 5 in Suit No. 1793 of 2017.

Learned counsel for the plaintiffs argued that in all four suits appeals of the plaintiffs before appellate authorities are pending alongwith stay applications but neither main appeals are being decided nor stay application but the department is pressing hard for the recovery

of demand, therefore, suits were filed for some restraining orders during pendency of appeals. Learned counsel also argued that plaintiffs will not press the suits if during pendency of appeal no coercive action shall be taken against the plaintiffs by the department and in case appeals are decided against the plaintiffs, they may be allowed to seek remedy within seven days without taking any coercive action against them by the department. Mr. Samad Ali submits that though he is holding brief for M/s Sarfaraz Ali Metlo and Amir Bux Metlo Advocates but both have given him specific instructions to concede to this proposal as some other cases have also been disposed of on the same terms yesterday by this Court.

In view of the above statement and consent of associate of M/s Sarfaraz Ali Metlo and Amir Bux Metlo Advocates the suits are disposed of in the above terms, alongwith pending applications. The appellate authorities may decide the appeals preferably within 30 days in accordance with law.
