Mr. Pervaiz Ahmed Memon Advocate files Vakalatnama for defendant No.2, which is taken on record.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that the appeal is pending before Commissioner Inland Revenue (Appeals-IV), Karachi and despite pendency of appeal, the defendant No.2 is pressing hard for the recovery. He proposes that he will not press the suit if learned counsel for the defendant No.2 concedes that during pendency of appeal no coercive action shall be taken against the plaintiff and in case appellate order goes against the plaintiff, seven days' time would be available to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for defendant No.2 concedes to this proposal, however, he submits that some direction may be issued to the Commissioner Appeals to decide the appeal expeditiously.

The suit is disposed of in the above terms. The defendant No.2 may preferably decide the appeal within 30 days.
