This is a suit for declaration, injunction and damages and the plaintiff has sought declaration that defendant No.1 cannot evict or dispossess the plaintiff from the subject property except in accordance with Section 15 of the Sindh Rented Premises Ordinance, 1979. Restraining order has also been sought against the defendants from interfering or dispossessing the plaintiff from the possession.

On the last date of hearing Mr. Arshad Tayyebaly learned counsel for defendant No.1 gave the proposal that in view of the prayer clause 1 made in the plaint the plaintiff shall not be dispossessed without due process of law. Today again he submits that without admitting the various allegations made in the plaint and on pure question of law he agrees that if the eviction of the plaintiff is required that will be done with due process of law. The plaintiff's counsel has also sought instructions from his client and agrees to the above proposal.

By consent of both the learned counsel the suit is disposed of in the above terms alongwith pending applications.
