Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: On 25.08.2016, learned counsel argued that despite pendency of appeal, the Deputy Commissioner, Regional Tax Office has issued demand notice for the recovery of outstanding amount. While issuing notice, this court restrained the defendants from taking any coercive action. Syed Mohsin Imam, learned counsel for the Tax Department submits that till disposal of appeal no coercive action shall be taken against the plaintiff. Learned counsel for the plaintiff agrees to this proposal, however, he submits that if appellate order goes against the plaintiff at least seven days' time may be allowed to seek appropriate remedy on which also the learned counsel for the Tax Department concedes to.

The suit is disposed of along with pending application in the above terms. The learned Appellate Authority may decide the appeal preferably within 30 days.
