Through this petition, the petitioner has claimed the following relief(s):-

- a) Quash the FIR No.96 of 2016 lodged at PS Mithi for offence U/s 365(B), 506, 34 PPC alongwith are its subsequent facts, being patently false and fabricated one.
- b) That the respondents No.3 to 5 no to harass the petitioner for her false involvement in criminal cases or to cause her arrest in above case/crime without permission of this Honourable Court.
- c) Grant any other relief which this Honourable Court may deem fit and proper.

Although today none is present on behalf of the petitioner, however the case of the petitioner is that she had married with respondent No.2 (Ghulam Mustafa) and from the said wedlock, there is one son namely Ghulam Rasool, aged about 02 years. It appears that respondent No.2 due to some matrimonial dispute, ousted the petitioner from his house with 'three cloths' and now she is residing at address given in the petition. It also appears from the record that a family suit in between the petitioner and the respondent No.2 is pending before the concerned Family Court, however an FIR bearing crime No.96 of 2016 of P.S. Mithi under section 365-B, 506, 34 P.P.C has been registered on the basis of allegation of abduction of the petitioner.

We have gone through the order dated 22.9.2016 passed by this Court, which shows that on the said date, the petitioner had appeared before this Court

and stated that nobody has kidnapped / abducted her and through this petition, the petitioner has prayed for protection and quashment of above said FIR.

As observed above, the petitioner has already admitted before this Court that nobody has kidnapped / abducted her, therefore this petition is disposed of with direction to the official respondents to make sure that there shall not be caused any harassment to the petitioner and her child. As far as the aforesaid FIR is concerned, in this respect Investigating Officer of the case is directed to record the statement of petitioner and submit the same before the concerned Court for passing appropriate orders.
