Urgent application moved by counsel for the plaintiff is granted.

Basically, through this suit the plaintiff has prayed for full and final settlement dues alongwith some mark-up including damages. Mr. Asim Iqbal, Advocate is appearing for the defendants and he has already filed the written statement in which they have denied the claim of the plaintiff. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for such dues or not, it requires evidence and since the written statement has been filed, it would be appropriate for the advancement of justice that the parties may file their proposed issues so that the matter may be fixed for evidence. Both learned counsel are directed to file their proposed issues. The CMA No.1465/2018 has been moved by the plaintiff under Section 151 CPC apprehension on some that the defendants will disconnect the domestic gas connection of

his abode. Mr. Nadeem Pirzada admits that the plaintiff is regularly paying the gas bill. Mr. Asim Iqbal submits that there is no such prayer in the main petition, however, he is of the view that if any consumer is regularly paying the bill, then there is no question of any disconnection. This application is disposed of with this order that if the plaintiff will regularly pay the bill and not violate the terms and conditions of the agreement, his gas connection shall not be disconnected.
