- 1. Urgent application filed by the counsel for the plaintiff is granted.
- 2. This is a suit for declaration, permanent injunction and damages. Precisely, the plaintiff has sought the directions against the defendant to disconnect the illegal power supply given to 261 encroachers and 180 illegal occupants within the plaintiff's residential colonies. The plaintiff has also prayed for further restraining order against the defendant from installing any further electricity meters in the plaintiff's residential colonies without first obtaining NOCs from the plaintiff. During the pendency of this suit, the plaintiff and defendant have entered into a settlement agreement which was signed on 27.02.2018 in which parties have settled some modalities to resolve the

dispute amicably. The application is supported by the affidavit of the authorized representative of the plaintiff Muhammad Latif, General Manager (Admin & Security). He has attached the extract of the minutes of 185th board meeting of PTCL in which so many persons including the general managers have been authorized to sign pleadings and documents, applications etc. on behalf of the plaintiff, whereas on behalf of K-Electric, Saleem Raza, Manager (Legal) has filed the affidavit. His authority letter is available at page 221 which shows that on 21.10.2015 he authorized by the defendant to sign statement, affidavits, applications, etc. in this suit. The authorized representatives of both the parties and their counsel have also singed the compromise application in the above suit. Both the affidavits are duly verified by the Identity Section Management System (ISMS), department of this court. In view of the above, this suit is decreed in terms of the compromise. Pending applications are also disposed of.
