In view of the order dated 11.04.2018 passed by the learned Division Bench of this court. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent No. 2, 5, 7 & 9 have filed joint statement. They submit that a meeting was convened between the petitioner and officers of the Karachi Fisheries Harbour Authorities and they have mutually resolved the dispute, therefore, they do not want to proceed further. At this stage, Imran ul Haq, Director (Legal), Maritime Security Agency is present. He submits that Agency has no objection on the amicable settlement between the petitioner and Karachi Fisheries Harbour Authorities. However, he submits that the repair of vessels in the harbour may be allowed subject to security clearance of Maritime Security Agency.
