None present for the petitioner. On 12.04.2018 also learned counsel for the petitioner was called absent and in the interest of justice the matter was adjourned with the caution that if the learned counsel for the petitioner will fail to appear the petition will be dismissed for non prosecution. Basically, the petitioner has sought the declaration that the letter dated 06.08.2013 issued by the Animal Husbandry Commissioner, whereby, he requested to the Sindh Chamber of Commerce & Industry to revoke the license of the petitioner's company is illegal. The petitioner applied for NOC for the import of 22,000 sheep from Australia on 22.08.2012 for slaughtering purpose. The NOC was issued but the electronic and print media broke a story regarding rejection of the consignment of the aforesaid sheep by Bahrain Government due to Scabby Mouth disease and Foot & Mouth disease and, thereafter, ship was re-directed to Karachi. The Ministry of National Food Security & Research conducted a Fact Finding Inquiry in the matter and the Inquiry Officer found that petitioner's company concealed the fact that the original consignment was destined for Bahrain and on rejection the ship was diverted to Karachi. The Inquiry Officer also recommended that petitioner's company may be blacklisted for any future import of live animal in Pakistan. Since nobody is present for the petitioner, matter is dismissed for non prosecution.
